Year 10 Examination Rules:

1. **Non-attendance:** Candidates who miss an exam are required to contact the Dean prior to commencement of the exam that is to be missed. A make up exam will be conducted on the day of their return, unless they already have two exams on that day, whereby other arrangements will be made.
2. **Arrival time:** Candidates are to arrive at the examination room at least 5 minutes prior to the commencement of the Examination Starting Time.
3. **Late arrival:** Late arrivals WILL NOT be given extra time.
4. **Communication between candidates:** Candidates must remain silent throughout the duration of the examination. No communication is permitted between candidates. Candidates breaking this rule will have their papers annotated by the Supervisor. A decision on forfeiture of marks will be made after the examination.
5. **Reading time:** Candidates are to put their writing instruments down, turn over their Examination Papers and begin reading. Candidates MAY NOT write during reading time.
6. **Movement during working time:** No student will be permitted to leave the Examination Room before the end of the Working Time (this includes toilet visits) except in the case of an emergency.
7. **Cheating:** Should any cheating be detected, the offender, together with the Examination and Answer Papers and any evidence of cheating will be removed to the side room and escorted to the Dean or Deputy Principal's Office at the first opportunity.
8. **Early finishing:** No student will be permitted to leave the examination room early. If you finish early, you should revise your work thoroughly, making additions and corrections where necessary.
9. **Borrowing equipment:** Candidates are not permitted to borrow equipment from other candidates.
10. **Departure:** At the end of the examination, candidates are not to move from their seat or speak to any other candidate until all examination papers have been collected and candidates have been instructed to leave the room. Waste paper must be placed in the bins provided. Please leave the Examination Room neat and tidy.
11. **Eating:** Under normal circumstances no eating is allowed. Under special circumstances a candidate may apply (to the Dean prior to the examination) for special arrangements to be made (eg. Diabetes).
12. **Drinking:** Candidates may bring water to the examination provided that the water is in a clear plastic bottle (all brand labels should be removed). The water bottle should have a secure lid and a capacity of no more than 1.5 litres. Water bottles may not be refilled during the examination.
13. **Permitted items:** Candidates may bring only the materials specified by their teacher. Pencil cases are not permitted (a clear case or plastic sleeve may be used but must then be placed under the chair. Any unauthorised materials must be left at the front of the Examination Room. Calculators may be checked during the examination.
14. **Other matters:** If you have an alarm on your watch it must be turned off so as not to distract other candidates. Mobile phones are not permitted in the exam room. They may be stored in a container in the exam room for the duration of the exam.
