Patrice Berthold

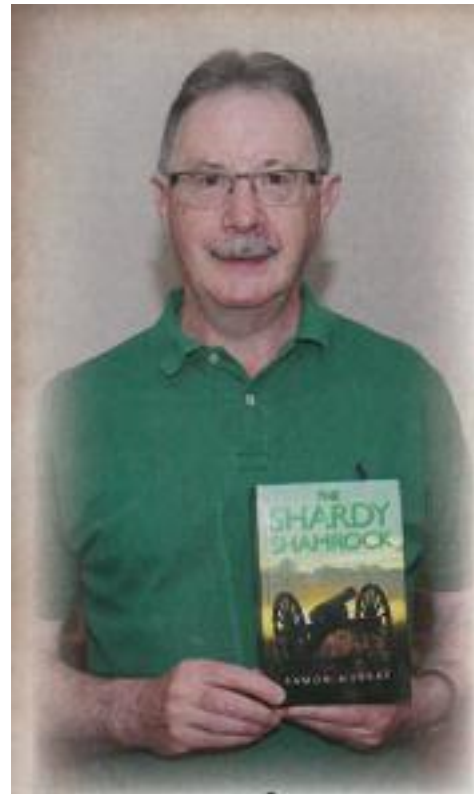
